



OFFICIAL LANGUAGES POLICY
(as at August 18, 2003)

Squash Canada recognizes that English and French languages enjoy equal status in Canada. Accordingly, Squash Canada recognizes that as a Sport Canada grant recipient, the Treasury Board policy on Official Languages applies [i.e. contributions made to voluntary non-governmental organizations serving the members of the public of both official language communities, communications with, and services to, that public are provided in both official languages].

Squash Canada will ensure that programs and services are offered to members in both Official Languages.

The impact of this policy on Squash Canada operations is that:

Squash Canada will:

- a) Collect language preference statistics on its membership; and work with leaders of both official language communities to ensure the needs of the community are met.
- b) Provide key operational, high performance and technical documents in both Official Languages.
- c) Make any announcements to the public concerning the activity, project, or program in both Official Languages.
- d) Ensure the static sections of the Squash Canada website are fully translated and up-to-date in both Official Languages.
